COMM 1-1 Why is the proposed rate not being offered to all low usage customers?

Response: The proposed Municipal Low Capacity Rate is intended to apply only to political subdivisions of the state, which in our service territory is mainly the Town of Burrillville. Pascoag is a tax exempt utility district (as codified in the enabling legislation in Chapter 45-58-15) which receives town services such as police and fire. This rate is intended to provide some level of reciprocity of public benefit to the Town, and through lowering town costs, ultimately to town taxpayers.
