

**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE OF  
NEXTERA ENERGY RESOURCES, LLC**

Pursuant to Rule 1.13 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure for the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”), NextEra Energy Resources, LLC (“NextEra”) hereby petitions the Commission for leave to intervene in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of this petition, NextEra states as follows:

1. NextEra is a leading producer of clean and renewable energy in North America. Through its affiliates, NextEra owns and operates a diverse portfolio of power generation resources across the United States and Canada that includes wind, natural gas, nuclear, solar, and oil. NextEra is the largest generator of wind and solar in North America, with a total generating capacity over 19, 000 megawatts from wind and the sun.
  
2. In New England, NextEra owns generating facilities and projects in Connecticut, Massachusetts, Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont, including solar generating projects in development owned by Chinook Solar, LLC, Farmington Solar, LLC, Quinebaug Solar, LLC, and Sanford Airport Solar LLC (the “NextEra Affiliates”). The NextEra Affiliates are counterparties to the Power Purchase Agreements (“PPAs”) submitted for approval in this proceeding.

3. The purpose of this proceeding is to review eight long-term PPAs, including four PPAs with NextEra Affiliates, associated with the procurement of renewable energy and renewable energy certificates.

4. Intervention in Commission proceedings is governed by Rule 1.13 of the Commission's

Rules of Practice and Procedure, which states:

Subject to the provisions of these rules, any person claiming a right to intervene or an interest of such nature that intervention is necessary or appropriate may intervene in any proceeding before the Commission. Such right or interest may be:

(1) A right conferred by statute.

(2) An interest which may be directly affected and which is not adequately represented by existing parties and as to which movants may be bound by the Commission's action in the proceeding. (The following may have such an interest: consumers served by the applicant, defendant, or respondent; holders of securities of the applicant, defendant, or respondent.)

(3) Any other interest of such nature that movant's participation may be in the public interest.

5. As a counterparty to four of the PPAs at issue in this proceeding, NextEra has a significant interest in the subject matter of this Docket that may be directly affected by the Commission's review and decision in this Docket. These interests are not adequately represented or protected by the existing parties in this Docket, and NextEra may be bound by the Commission's action in this Docket.

6. NextEra's participation in this Docket will be in the public interest.

WHEREFORE, NextEra, requests that the Commission grant its Motion to Intervene, that it be granted status as a party in this proceeding, and that the Commission grant all other relief it deems meet and just.
