**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws §39-3-11, as amended, the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) will conduct a hearing on **Thursday, March 7, 2019 @ 9:30 A.M.** in Hearing Room A at the PUC's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island.

In this docket, the PUC will examine a filing by The Narragansett Electric d/b/a National Grid (Company) seeking approval of a proposed Gas Infrastructure, Safety and Reliability Plan for fiscal year 2020 (ISR Plan). The ISR Plan is submitted pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-1-27.7.1 which provides for an annual gas infrastructure, safety and reliability spending plan for each fiscal year and an annual rate reconciliation mechanism that includes a reconcilable allowance for the anticipated capital investments and other spending pursuant to an annual pre-approved budget. The proposed ISR Plan addresses capital spending on gas infrastructure and other costs related to the maintaining the safety and reliability of the Company's gas distribution system. The proposed ISR Plan would account for additional revenues of \$7.3 million that will be collected through the Distribution Adjustment Charge for the period April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020. The bill impact on an average residential heating customer using 845 therms annually would result in an annual increase of \$20.81 or 1.6%. The PUC may approve a different charge that may be higher or lower than that proposed by National Grid. The PUC may rule immediately at the conclusion of the hearing.
