NOTICE OF FILING AND DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS

Pursuant to the provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-8 and the Public Utilities Commission's (PUC) Rule of Practice and Procedure 810-RICR-00-00-1.11 (C), on December 21, 2018, Energy Development Partners, LLC (Petitioner), a developer of renewable energy projects, filed a Petition for Declaratory Judgment. Specifically, the Petitioner seeks a determination that for the purpose of entering into a Public Entity Net Metering Financing Arrangement as that term is defined in the Rhode Island Net Metering statute at R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.4-2(16)(i), the requirement that an eligible net metering resource be located on property "owned or controlled" by the public entity or municipality is satisfied by granting an irrevocable license over the property.

The PUC hereby gives notice that it will accept written objections with a memorandum of law or comments in support of Petitioner's Petition until 4:00 p.m. on February 1, 2019. All filings shall be made electronically to luly.massaro@puc.ri.gov and an original and nine (9) hard copies shall be provided to Luly Massaro, Public Utilities Commission, 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, RI 02888.
