NATIONAL GRID’S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

National Grid¹ respectfully requests a two-week extension of time to April 22, 2021 to file either revised consensus language, partial consensus language, or alternatives for the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (“PUC”) to consider regarding the Company’s Standards for Connecting Distributed Generation (“DG Tariff”). As grounds for this motion, National Grid states as follows:

1. The Revised Procedural Schedule in this docket provides in part that by April 8, 2021: “Parties will either file revised consensus language, partial consensus language, or alternatives for the Commission to consider and, if necessary, conduct a hearing. If there is full consensus language, National Grid shall file testimony explaining the consensus. If there is partial consensus or no consensus, the parties shall file their respective language together with testimony explaining and supporting their position. The matter will then be scheduled for a hearing.” Revised Procedural Schedule at p. 2.
2. National Grid seeks this two-week extension of time since National Grid is still in discussions with the Rhode Island Division of Public Utilities and Carriers, the Rhode Island Office of Energy Resources and the Northeast Clean Energy Council (collectively, the “Parties”) in efforts to reach consensus language for the DG Tariff modifications.

3. The additional time will allow National Grid and the Parties to continue their discussions in efforts to reach consensus language, if possible.
4. National Grid has conferred with the Parties regarding this Motion, and the Parties do not object to this Motion.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, National Grid respectfully requests that the PUC grant this Motion for Extension of Time.
