**NOTICE OF FILING AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to the provisions of the R.I.G.L. §39-3-15 et seq. as amended, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (Division) will conduct a public hearing on **Tuesday, November 24, 2015 at 10:00 A.M.** in Hearing Room A at the Division's office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island.

At this hearing, the Division will consider the propriety of an application by the Pawtucket Water Supply Board (PWSB) seeking approval to borrow an amount not to exceed \$4,718,000 through revenue bonds to be sold by the Rhode Island Infrastructure Bank for the Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds will be used to finance improvements to the PWSB's distribution system.

The application is on file and may be examined at the Division's office. Reference is made to Chapters 39-1, 39-3 and 42-35 of the RI General Laws. The Division of Public Utilities and Carriers is accessible to the handicapped. Individuals requesting interpreter services for the hearing impaired must notify the Clerk's office at 780-2107 seventy-two hours in advance of hearing date.
