NOTICE OF FILING AND PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island General Laws, § 39-1-1 and 39-3-15, as amended, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (Division) will conduct a public hearing on **Monday, November 20, 2017 at 10:00 A.M.** in Hearing Room B of the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers, located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island.

At this hearing, the Division will consider the propriety of an application filed by the City of Woonsocket Water Division seeking consent and approval to obtain financing in the amount not to exceed twelve million five hundred thousand dollars (\$12,500,000) through revenue bonds to be sold by the Rhode Island Infrastructure Bank, formerly, the Rhode Island Clean Water Finance Agency for the Rhode Island Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. The funds will be used to support costs associated with the engineering, design and construction of a new drinking water treatment plant to replace the existing Charles Hammann Drinking Water Treatment Plant.
