**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to the provisions of the Rhode Island General Laws, Sections 39-1-1 and 39-3-25, as amended, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (the “Division”) will conduct a public hearing on **Monday, December 13, 2021 @ 10:00 A.M.** in the first floor hearing room of the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island. The hearing may continue thereafter from day to day and time to time as required. The hearing will be streamed live at <https://video.ibm.com/channel/WqQyXw296dg>.

At this hearing, the Division will consider and examine the propriety of a joint petition submitted by PPL Corporation (“PPL”), PPL Rhode Island Holdings, LLC (“PPL Rhode Island”), National Grid USA (“National Grid USA”) and The Narragansett Electric Company (“Narragansett”) (collectively “Petitioners”) on May 4, 2021. The joint petition seeks Division approval for the transfer of ownership of Narragansett to PPL Rhode Island pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws §§ 39-3-24 and 39-3-25. The proposed transaction, if approved, would result in PPL Rhode Island assuming management and control of all gas and electric distribution service in Rhode Island that is currently owned and operated by Narragansett.
